**Regarding technology:** Please note that all of the secondary schools possess Internet accessibility with 95% having high-speed access. Each school requires students to abide by an *Acceptable Use Policy for Technology*, and 95% filter Internet access. More than half of the secondary schools have wireless access available to students and 25% also utilize *Palm*-type hand-held computers. Four schools have video conferencing capabilities for distance learning. On average, there is one computer for every three students.
